

Anti-stain treatment of furniture fabrics

Anti-stain treatment means finishing of fabric by adding substances to the fabric's surface.

Gabriel mainly supplies wool, wool/polyamide blends and polyester fabrics.

These fibers are easy to maintain and clean according to Gabriel's maintenance and stain guide and without use of anti-stain treatments.

Gabriel does not add or advise to add any unnecessary chemicals and surface treatments.

Wool has dirt-repelling properties from nature and most stains can be removed easily using only water and a pH-neutral detergent.

Furthermore, Gabriel wool products are dry cleanable.

Anti-stain treatments can have a negative effect on the wool's natural properties.

Anti-stain treatments are not necessary on Gabriel's polyester fabrics as most stains can be removed easily using only water and a neutral detergent.

Furthermore, our polyester fabrics are washable or dry cleanable.

For uses in environments with substantial soiling, we recommend not to choose delicate, light colors.

Regarding microfiber: As the only Gabriel design, Comfort+ is treated with an anti-stain treatment as standard. The treatment is necessary in this microfiber design to protect against stains. Comfort+ is, as all other Gabriel fabrics, PFAS free and tested according to Oekotex Standard 100.
